Assistant principals are invited to attend this professional development workshop sponsored by the Missouri Association of Secondary School Principals.

The conference will begin on Sunday afternoon with Ted Bruce, Deputy Chief Counsel of the Public Safety Division of the Missouri Attorney General's Office, discussing how the Fourth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution applies to school employees. Policies schools should have in place and announce in order to conduct lawful searches, liability issues that schools should consider, and searches that have generally been disfavored by the courts are a few of the topics he will address. There will be an opportunity for a question and answer session.

Following this session assistant principals will be divided into middle school and high school groups to network about issues of concern, successful programs, or to share a best practice.

Monday morning, Tom Quinn, DESE Director of School Governance, will address participants on a wide range of issues, including: student residency, attendance policies, pupil transportation, school district boundary lines, school elections, facility needs, and school safety. His presentation will primarily focus on residency laws and what parents complain about when they call DESE.

Prior to lunch there will be two rounds of concurrent breakout sessions covering a variety of topics that will be of interest to assistant principals.

During the last general session Duane Martin, an attorney with the Doster, Mickes, James & Ullom Law Firm, will present on the topic *Legal Issues Affecting Assistant Principals*.

This conference, based on the ISLLC Standards, will be recognized as six hours of professional development credit toward re-certification.
